

## English National Cross Country Champs – Parliament Hill Sat 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb 2025

## Kate O'Neill was a brilliant tenth in her first English National appearance for five years as over 20 Havering athletes tackled the treacherous muddy conditions at the National Cross Country Championships at the iconic Parliament Hill course on Saturday.

After finishing fourth at the recent Southern Championships Kate had set herself a target of a top ten National finish and she achieved this in a tight finish ahead of 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> placed athletes. It was an early birthday present for the Brentwood based athlete who celebrated her 24<sup>th</sup> birthday the following day and it was Kate's third top ten National finish to match her two placing as an Under 20. Her performance led the Havering squad to 24<sup>th</sup> place in the team standings as Ginte Bailey was 134<sup>th</sup>, one place better than her last National three years ago, with Robyn Matson 181<sup>st</sup> for her best position since 2014 with Clare Davies' in 421<sup>st</sup> completing the scoring quartet with Rebecca O'Rourke in 505<sup>th</sup> of the 830 finishers.

The **Under 20 Women** were the highest placed club team in eleventh in the three-to-score competition as Maddie Barker came home in 43<sup>rd</sup> with Hannah Evans finishing 65<sup>th</sup> and 97<sup>th</sup> placed Charlotte Evans making up the club trio.

The **Under 15 Girls** also fielded a complete team, finishing 22<sup>nd</sup> as Poppy Vines was 99<sup>th</sup>, Jasmine Asmal in 164<sup>th</sup>, Ruby Beasley in 185<sup>th</sup> and Jessie Lynes in 264<sup>th</sup> ensuring a full scoring four all gaining experience of the challenging muddy and hilly National course.

There were incomplete teams in the other age groups. For the **Senior Men** James Stewart led the way in 278<sup>th</sup> and Jason Crispin and Gary Atkins were 1078<sup>th</sup> and 1085<sup>th</sup> of the almost 1800 finishers. The **Under 13 Girls** were one short of a scoring four as Lucy Tregidgo was 193<sup>rd</sup>, Violet Everett 241<sup>st</sup> and Isla Herrera 257<sup>th</sup> all getting a taste of the National action. The **Under 13 Boys** were represented by Callum Millard Jennings in 276<sup>th</sup> and Cruz Carvell in 299<sup>th</sup> while Grace Tilson flew the flag for the **Under 17 Women** in 191<sup>st</sup> and Liam Battrum placed 306<sup>th</sup> and was the only **Under 15 Boy** competing.
