

Essex Cross Country League – Round 4 – Writtle Sat 30th November

There was an individual win for James Stewart for the senior men and a team win for the senior women to confirm that they have lifted the league title with one match to spare, as the club jointly hosted the fourth round of the Essex Cross Country League with Chelmsford AC at a very muddy Writtle University course on Saturday.

The **Senior Women** made it three consecutive league wins to establish an unbeatable lead at the top of the league table with only the final match of five to come in the New Year. The squad welcomed back Birmingham University student Natalie Sewell for her first appearance this winter to place an excellent fourth as Lydia Smith repeated her sixth-place finish from Round 1. Robyn Matson was a fine ninth with Morgan Campbell two places back in 11th as the scoring four's 30-point tally was enough to hold off Chelmsford's challenge by two points. Hannah Evans again made the top 20 in 18th as twin Charlotte was 24th ahead of Clare Davies in 28th and Rebecca O'Rourke in 32nd as Amy Leech (81st) and Jane Hallam (107th) also saw action.

James Stewart had a great run to take his first ever Essex League win for the **Senior Men** tracking the leading Southend pair before coming out on top. James was followed home by Rob Warner in sixth place, which confirmed that Warner has won the Vet 40 individual league title with a race to go. Kieran O'Hara ran well for seventh, with Sam Atkins was next home in 27th place with Charlie Burgess 38th and Will Kirk one place back completing the second placed scoring team as Southend won again to confirm the league title. Sam Mahoney 43rd, Jason Lendon 51st, and Nathan Hart 65th were all in the top seventy, with Luke Chester 71st, Ian Anthony 73rd, Ryan Carroll 80th, Matt Bland 83rd, and Rob Trevor 87th, all making the top one hundred.

Shane Hart 102nd, Louis Berrett 123rd, Gary Atkins 150th, Steve Walker 160th. Graham Hogan 164th, Darren Priestley 194th, Paul Berrett 202nd and Tony Collins 223rd completed the 22-strong Havering squad.

After making the top 10 at the Liverpool Cross Challenge last week Freddie Rowe returned to county action to finish runner up in the **Under 17 race** as Sam Horsley was fifth, but the pair lacked a third scorer. In contrast the Under 17 women had a full turn out as Rosie Warner was 14th, Grace Tilson I 16th and Daisy Leech 22nd combined to place fourth with Abi Rogers in 23rd.

Both **Under 15** teams placed fourth. Poppy Vines was a good sixth for the girls with Elena Williams in 19th, Jasmine Asmal in 21st and Daisy Cossey-Atkins in 25th made up the scoring four with Skye Eastman 43rd. Aidan Doherty and Joe Sewell were 12th and 13th for the boys as Jake Tregidgo was 24th on his debut with Sean Mugagga the fourth scorer and Ethan Carroll (40th), Liam Battrum 46th and George Wright 51st also providing support.

The **Under 13 Girls** were fifth thanks to Lucy Tregidgo (15th), Bethany Friel (17th), Eliza Mesher (24th) and 26th placed Megan Murphy the scorers with Elsie Smith 32nd. There were just two **Under 13 Boys** as Callum Millard Jennings was sixth and Cruz Carvell 23rd.

There is now a two-month gap before the league's fifth and final fixture at Hockley in February before which there are a number of championships starting with the Masters County Championship event at Writtle next Saturday (14th).
