A strong Havering YDL Under 17 and Under 20 squad comfortably won their final league fixture at Crawley on Sunday to confirm their Division 1 title and promotion to the Southern Premier Division next summer, returning to the topflight for the first time since 2019.

The **Under 17 Men's** squad scored strongly with 11 wins and eight second places. They were boosted by the availability of Joel Ajayi, fresh from his selection for the European Under 18 Championships later this month, who cruised to 100m victory and improved his 200m best to make it a sprint double, and Emmanuel Asirifi-Otchere improved his best for B string runners up spot. Freddie Rowe won the 1500m from the front and added a second place in the steeplechase. Simeon Barker's winning debut a the 400m hurdles saw him go straight into the club all-time top ten and he later won the B triple jump and was third in the sprint hurdles. Zak Williams won the B sprint hurdles in a new PB, and was third in both the vault and javelin. Ryan Alexander won the A high hump and Findlay McLaren won the B, and was 800m runners up, as Shea Sweeney smashed his PB as he lost out on 800m B string win in the final strides. Ugo Godwin won the A triple jump and was second in the B shot and third in the B discus and he was partnered by Freddie Hatcher who set a new PB for second in the A discus, and was third in the shot. Tobias Samuel was third in the long jump and he combined with Maxwell Adeosun, Emmanual Asirifi-Otchere and Joel Ajayi who were second in the sprint relay. Simeon Barker, Freddie Rowe, Shea Sweeney and Findlay McLaren won the 4x400m relay in the fastest time by a club U17 team since 2019.

The **Under 20 Women's** team were much stronger this time and registered six wins. Southern medallist Cassie Campbell was an impressive winner in the 200m after finishing runner up in the 100m. Stephanie Osuala improved her best to win the B 100m and jumped to a triple jump PB in third. Olivia Boachie came through strongly for B 200m victory and Stephanie Okoro was well clear in winning the 400m hurdles. This quartet won the sprint relay in the fastest time by a club Under 20 Women's team for several years. Katie Ennis was discus winner and hammer runner up, and Maddie Barker was second in the 800m as Abigail swan was third in the B string, and Hannah Evans added second place points in the B javelin.

The **Under 17 Women's** team registered a strong al round performance. Lucy Chapelhow won the steeplechase and B discus and was third in the 300m hurdles, and Alicia Fairmaner was close to her recent PB in winning the long jump, as Amy Mansell was B long jump runner up after improving her 300m PB with a strong finish, and was third in the B 80m hurdles. Mya Thomas set a new PB for second in the 100m B race and Oma Nwapa set a new PB for third in the 80m hurdles, and was second in the high jump. Scarlett Woods won the pole vault, and was second in both the B 300m hurdles and A javelin. Grace Tillson's was second in both the B shot and B triple ump (PB) and improved her 800m PB. Eboni Roach was second in the shot and discus and third in the hammer. Mya, Amy, Oma and Alicia were second in the sprint relay.

The **Under 20 Men** had their strongest squad this season. Dan Lammas set a season's best to win the 400m B race, for their only win, and was third in the high jump. Michae I Tesi was in fine form improving his PBs in all his three throwing events, placing second in the javelin and third in both shot and discus. Maxwell Adeosun stepped up and age group to place second in the B 200m in a new PB and another Under 17 Adrian Shalujo-Afolabi was third in the triple jump, as was Toby Johnson in the B 800m.

The squad's win at Crawley, added to the victory in round two and runners up spot in the first match saw Havering top the table well ahead of their main opponents Crawley and Medway & Maidstone and they will now compete against the top five Southern teams in next year's competition.
