

## Essex Cross Country League – Round 3 – Colchester Sat 16<sup>th</sup> November

## The clash with the London Youth Games badly affected club teams at the third round of the Essex Cross Country League at Colchester Hilly Field on Saturday.

The **Senior Women** won for the second consecutive match and head the league table with two of the five fixtures to come. After a comfortable win in round two Kate O'Neill did not have it all her own way this time and came from behind late on to overhaul Basildon's Gemma Kersey for victory. Although missing three regular team members, the squad performed brilliantly as Bath University student Maddie Barker was 10<sup>th</sup>, just ahead of Morgan Campbell in 11<sup>th</sup> and Hannah Evans' 19<sup>th</sup> place ensured the team's tally was good enough to beat Colchester Harriers by three points. Charlotte Evans in 27<sup>th</sup>, Rebecca O'Rourke in 53<sup>rd</sup>, Clare Rudgley 115<sup>th</sup> and Jane Hallam in 132<sup>nd</sup> completed the line up.

Despite missing all four scorers from last time, a fourth-place finish for the **Under 15 Girls** was enough to give them a narrow lead at the top of the table. Daisy Cossey-Atkins in 17<sup>th</sup> was first club member home and Callie Ziepe (32<sup>nd</sup>), Olivia Bradbury 37<sup>th</sup> and Alex Field in 38<sup>th</sup> ensured a scoring four with Holly Bradbury and Skye Eastman just behind in 39<sup>th</sup> & 40<sup>th</sup>.

The **Senior Men** were third as Colchester Harriers made home advantage count ahead of league leaders Southend and Havering. James Stewart led the squad home for the first time in fourth with Kieran O'Hara not far behind in fifth. Ben Davis in 10th was closely followed by Rob Warner in 11<sup>th</sup>, and Sam Atkins 29th and Ryan Carroll 42nd completed the scoring team.

Charlie Burgess 52nd, Will Kirk 54th and Jason Lendon 58th were all in the top sixty. Barry Smith 77th, Nathan Hart 78th, Ian Anthony 80th, Matt Bland 89th and Rob Trevor 97th all ducked under the one hundred mark. Louis Berrett 132nd, Toby Johnson 153rd, Gary Atkins 156th and Steve Walker 157th were followed home by Darren Priestley 199th and Paul Berrett 209th who completed the twenty Havering runners.

The **Under 13 Boys** and **Under 15 Boys** both placed fifth. For the **Under 13s** Harrison Sewell was first home in 19<sup>th</sup>, with 21<sup>st</sup> placed Cruz Carvell and Archie Bright (28<sup>th</sup>) and Harrison Nolan (35<sup>th</sup>) the scorers ahead of Jack Rowlandson (36<sup>th</sup>), Cameron Smith (38<sup>th</sup>) with Samuel Kirk in 42<sup>nd</sup>. For the **Under 15s** Joe Sewell was 15<sup>th</sup>, Ethan Carroll was 21<sup>st</sup> and Sean Mugagga and George Burgess were the scorers in 24<sup>th</sup> and 40<sup>th</sup>.

There was just one club runner for each of the **Under 17 men** and the **Under 13 Girls** as Findlay McLaren was a seventh for the Under 17s and Inari Rawle placed 28<sup>th</sup> for the under 13 Girls.

A busy weekend saw club athletes in action at four other events.

Twenty-one club members represented the Havering Borough team in the London Youth Games at the tough Parliament Hill Course on Saturday. Freddie Rowe was highest placed, finishing a fine fourth in the Under 17 race, while in the Under 15 Girls' race Orla Friel was a good ninth and Poppy Vines 14<sup>th</sup>.

James Connor celebrated his England Call up by leading home the M40 team and winning his age group category at the home counties international on a tough undulating course in Belfast. James moved into the lead from second place behind the Scottish athlete with just over a kilometre to go, helping the England team finish third, behind strong Ireland and Scotland teams.

Lauren Reed returned from injury to represent Essex in the Southern Inter Counties 10k Championships held in conjunction with the Brighton 10k on Sunday. She was second placed W40 and 15<sup>th</sup> female finisher overall with her 36:35 clocking, as the Essex quartet were fourth.

There was a team bronze at the Eastern Counties Championships at Bury St Edmunds as Ginte Bailey (7<sup>th</sup>) Robyn Matson (9<sup>th</sup>) and Clare Davies (16<sup>th</sup>) edged out Hunts AC for a podium place.
